GO GET TRAE broke sharply, came under pressure through the turn, kicked clear to be much the best. SPIRITUAL DUTY settled back to be the early trailer, gained position along the inside of the turn, picked off one more rival in the stretch to improve for the place award. LIL HENRY was bumped at the start, raced behind the pace between rivals, made minor improvements. HADDA HAVE IT was bumped at the start, tracked the pace three wide, failed to menace. CAJUN DANCE moved up to press the pace shortly after the start, took a bad step at the quarter and was pulled up, escorted off in an equine ambulance. DAYOFTHEWARRIOR settled off the pace, taken up after coming into contact with SURFIN BAYOU at the half, pulled up and walked off. SURFIN BAYOU tracked the pace three deep along the inside, took a bad step just before the half interfering with DAYOFTHEWARRIOR, pulled up, escorted off in an equine ambulance. STEWARDS INQUIRY REGARDING THE INCIDENTS AT THE HALF AND QUARTER RESULTED IN NO CHANGE.
