SLICK AND FAST was pinched back at the start, waited patiently off the pace until the far turn, split foes to gain position and repositioned on the inside after rounding the turn, tipped out four wide inside the furlong and surged to be up just in time. CAPTIVATING STAR raced not too far behind the pace between rivals, launched a five wide bid in the upper stretch to take command at the eighth but was nailed by driving foe. TURF MONSTER found position in the middle of the pack, took to the far outside at the quarter and rallied for the show award. FLASH N CLASS saved ground to track the pace from the inside, made a three wide bid at the three sixteenths for a brief lead but flattened out soon after. MUNNINGS CATSLE settled to trail through the first turn, steadily

advanced four wide, angled out six wide at the three sixteenths to finish well. ACHROMEDOUTCAT broke swiftly to set the early pace, started to come under pressure in the far turn and ultimately gave way at the three sixteenths. TENSAS CAMP ROAD tracked the pace three wide, squeezed back at the quarter and flattened out. MI SOLUTION rushed up to stalk the early pace from the two path, retreated in the stretch. TONTERIA settled off the pace, never threatened. JACKSON D was pinched back at the start, trailed after the first turn, passed tired rival in the stretch. PETITFOR slightly rank approaching the first turn, raced along the inside of the middle of the pack, retreated in the far turn.
