JUST BERNIE broke a step slow, raced off the pace, began making progress in the far turn to enter the stretch along the outside, surged pass the competition to claim the victory. MCGINNIS was off a beat slow, found position around the middle of the pack, began to rally five wide through the stretch, claimed a brief lead at the sixteenth before being overtaken by the winner. ZUN REYDER settled off the pace on the inside, angled out six wide entering the stretch to rally for the show award. FILM AT ELEVEN tracked the pace four deep, closed some ground to press the pace in the final furlong but flattened out soon after. ROYAL IRISH raced five wide in the middle of the pack, began closing ground in the far turn to press the pace by the eighth, faltered. RIVAGE

broke slowly, raced off the pace, passed tiring rivals. TEQUILA N' SALT was off slowly, trailed for most, began to make progress in the far turn, picked off a few more rivals in the stretch. GOT STRIPES showed good early speed, retreated in the final furlong. BONAFIDE tracked the pace three deep, retreated in the far turn. PENCIL BLUFF was the first to race behind the pace until the quarter, retreated in the final furlong. MIDNIGHT VENGEANCE raced in the middle off the pack, backed off to trail at the quarter, eased across.
