MY MAN BRANDON settled off the pace five wide, gained position in the turn before driving past the rest to lead by the eighth, kept on through the finish. BAYOU TIME settled off the pace along the inside, gained position through the turn, made a four wide bid to split foes at the three sixteenths, held at bay by the winner. TAUREAN settled back to be the early trailer, closed willingly along the outside of the stretch for the show award. LOUISIANA STAR tracked the early pace four wide, backed off in the turn, failed to menace. JAYJAYJAY pressed the early pace under a tight rein, moved up between foes to vie for command through the turn, continued to duel in the upper stretch but was overtaken at the eighth, faded then on. CUSTOM SPARK showed good early speed, came under pressure in the turn, retreated at the three sixteenths. CHARLIE GAMER was off a beat slow, moved up between foes to stalk the pace three wide in the turn, retreated in the stretch. OCEAN VOYAGER settled off the pace before the turn, trailed by the quarter.
