BURNING MUNNY Close up inside, challenged at the top of the lane, kicked clear briefly and faded. DEPUTY TRAMON Unhurried along the rail and failed to rally. H B PLAISANCE Vied for the lead from between to the lane and gave way. JOHN THE BAPTIST Vied for the lead three across and gave way.
