REDOUBTABLERIPKEN In hand along the two path, angled wide and closed fast for the win. TAP IT EASY Well placed along the rail, eased out, took the lead at the sixteenths pole and then was caught late. NOT TODAY GOVERNOR Set the pace along the two path, was collared and faded. SUPPORT THE CAT Saved ground and weakened. GIMME GIMME Five wide on the turn, was not a factor. SWIFT BANK Tracked along the two path and tired. REAL ELEVE Close up four wide to the lane and was done. PERCY Ducked out at the start, five wide on the turn far back, was outrun. REV PARKER Four wide on the turn, was always outrun.
