NUMERIC In hand along the two path, three path around, angled out, reached the lead in gear and drew clear. DIVA BANKER Tracked along the three path, stayed on that path into the lane, challenged to no avail but finished well. RED BUTTERFLY Set the pace along the rail, was collared, battled and faded. MISS PAB Lagged back five wide, four wide around and finished wide. LADY QUINN Hopped at the start, tracked five wide, challenged along the two path at the top of the lane and tired. MRS BELL Three path on the turn, dropped back and then was eased over the wire.
