RETAIL MAN close up after a half, quickly found the lead into the last turn, dropped to the two path midway around, opened up a lengthy lead and was ridden out. MAD MAGIC unhurried four wide early, stayed wide into the lane appearing to be in gear, three path into the lane and passed a tiring THIRTY OYSTERS for the place. THIRTY OYSTERS vied four wide early, two path after a half, tracked into the lane and weakened. CO CONSPIRATOR vied five wide early, three path after that and was done on the last turn. GLIDING AFLEET five wide on the first turn, took the rail after that and tired. IRON MAN IRA unhurried four wide around the first turn, three path after that to the lane and tired.
