PAINT THE LINE Volleyed for the lead along the rail, kicked loose some and under pressure drew clear late. LOOKIN' SUPER Hopped at the start, well placed along the three path, four wide into the lane and rallied. ALMOND CIDER Vied for the lead along the two path, chased and weakened. PROFITABILITY In hand along the rail, took the three path into the lane, appeared in tight at the sixteenths pole and checked. SEVENTH RACE SHAKE Trailed four wide, five wide into the lane, was not a factor. ARI'S MAGIC Close up along the two path into the turn and tired.
