COOL HAND RICH Sprinted clear, showed the way with a lengthy lead while three from the rail, was collared and finished second best. SUPPORT THE CAT Unhurried four wide, two path on the bend, angled out and made a late bid. CRUISING CAT Close up along the rail and failed to fire inside. SHARP PLAY BOY Unhurried five wide, four wide into the lane and failed to threaten. NOT TODAY GOVERNOR Broke a step slow, close up along the three path into the turn, four wide out of it and was done. JUST A GUY Six wide early, was outrun. PEELING OUT Fractious in the gate, broke slow and was always outrun.
