ASSET MANAGEMENT In hand four wide, three path into the turn, four wide out of it, challenged three across and under pressure proved best. ALWAYS PACKEN Close up along the three path, challenged, battled between to no avail but finished second best. PROPITIUS Well placed along the two path, eased out and was along for a share. KING SOLOMON Set the pace along the two path, was collared, battled inside and faded. STRONGEST LINK In hand along the rail, two path around and failed to fire. KING SILKYMILKY Unhurried five wide, three path around, was not a factor. CALL SAUL Two path into the turn, was never a factor. MALCOLM'S RUSH Broke two lengths slow, was outrun. SHEA D VOTING Tracked, bolted into the turn, took up into the lane and was eased. The Inquiry sign was posted concerning the race, resulted in no change.
