MAD MAGIC In hand along the rail, two path into the final turn, four wide leaving it, responded and rallied wide to best BETA on the wire. BETA Tracked along the three path, three path on the final turn, collared the leader, gained the advantage and was caught on the wire. RETAIL MAN Ducked in slamming MR. EINSTEIN at the start, lagged back, saved ground, rallied inside and hung in the crucial stages. IT'S NOT OVER YET Sprinted to the front, showed the way a lengthy lead, was collared a furlong out and faded. FINALIST Tracked early while along the three path and tired. MR. EINSTEIN Slammed at the start, three path on the turns and tired.
