KEIGS Close up along the two path, appeared to wait nearing the quarter pole, was cut loose into the lane, reached the leader from the inside and wore that one down for the win. REBEL EMPIRE Vied for the lead along the rail, took charge leaving the five-sixteenths pole, took the two path into the lane leaving the rail open, was challenged inside by the winner at the furlong marker, battled that one but could not match strides late. KHALI'S DREAM Close up four wide into the turn, challenged three across at the furlong marker, matched strides briefly and weakened late. LOOKIN' SUPER Hopped at the start, lagged back, four wide into the lane and rallied. GANDY DANCING Lagged back along the three path, two path on the bend, was outrun. NORGAY Close up five wide, four wide into the stretch and tired. STONE GUITAR Vied for the lead along the three path into the turn and was done into the lane. ALMOND CIDER Six wide around and tired.
