BUSTIN PIETRE Tracked five wide, challenged four wide, chased, appeared in tight between rivals the sixteenths pole, took up and out. BROCKMONINOFF Away on top, set the pace along the rail, was collared at the top of the lane, responded, kicked clear and then could not sustain the momentum. TRAPPE THE DREAM Lagged back along the three path, two path on the turn and failed to threaten inside. MATTY'S EXPRESS Close up along the two path, took the rail around and tired. BAY BANK Well placed along the three path, five wide into the lane and tired. Stewards inquiry was posted concerning the incident at the sixteenths pole, resulted in no change.
