SARATOGA BANKER Showed the way along the two path, responded to open up some and was under the whip to the wire. THE DELAWARE BOYZ Tracked four wide, three path around, chased and finished well. CIVIL SERVICE Unhurried four wide, angled out and made a late bid. RIBBONS AND MEDALS Tracked early, two path into the turn, four wide out of it and finished with interest. INTERCHANGER Three path early, four wide on the turn and lacked a solid bid. SMOKIN' ALONE Close up three from the rail into the bend, took the rail out of it and tired. COLTEN GOES Broke slow, saved ground and tired. DON'T POKE THE CAT Five wide on the turn and finished wide. SMOOTH TALES Four wide around and tired.
