G MUNNING Vied three across early, duelled around, kicked clear some and held on stubbornly. NUTSIE In hand along the rail, eased out a path and finished well. TRAPPE THE DREAM Unhurried along the three path, two path around, altered course to the outside nearing the sixteenths pole and finished well. TETSU Unhurried along the rail and made a late bid inside. STORMIN SAMMY Vied from between early, tracked the leaders four wide into the lane and tired. ENTICING PROSPECT Unhurried five wide, six wide into the lane and finished wide. BETA Five wide on the bend and tired. BROCKMONINOFF Close up along the three path to the lane and tired. INTERSTATE Saved ground throughout. SHARPAZ Vied for the lead along the two path and gave way.
