BLESSED VISION bobbled at the start then prompted SHARP LORENZO racing two-wide,. offered a bid nearing the half mile pole, was brushed by that rival nearing the three-eighths pole then dueled with him from that point and prevailed under strong hand;ing. SHARP LORENZO saved ground setting the pace, came out to brush with BLESSED VISION nearing the three-eighths pole, dueled with that one from that point but wasn't quite good enough in a game effort. MR OKLAHOMA settled in the back of the field, came three-wide into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. TUCKER FLATS saved ground racing in the middle of the field and went evenly late. WEST COAST COWBOY was allowed to settle racing three-wide but lacked a rally. CHEROKEE SUNRISE was forwardly placed early racing three-wide ad weakened. DANCING DEVIL was prominently place early racing two-wide and tired.
