NORMA JEAN BLING was carried out entering the first turn, was unhurried, rallied around the second turn, swung wide entering the stretch and closed with a rush to get up in the final strides. BILLIE BABY stalked the pace four wide, rallied into the second turn to challenge, dueled for the lead and was caught late. POSETIVELY PERFECT came in entering the first turn and was checked, moved up along the backstretch to challenge, dueled to the final strides and was outfinished. UNBRIDLED KISSES was crowded and checked entering the first turn, stayed close while racing inside, dropped back on the second turn and lacked a stretch bid. COWGIRLSLIKEBLING was sent to the front, led to the backstretch, dropped back and was transported off the track via an equine ambulance. RAILEY JEAN was checked and veered out sharply entering the first turn and always outrun. LA CAMELIA was slow early, closed along the rail and was shut off and checked late. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY, POSETIVELY PERFECT WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH FOR CAUSING INTERFERENCE INTO THE FIRST TURN.
