GOOD PRODUCT unhurried early, began to move closer late in the second turn in the three path, continued to gain through the final bend, engaged the leader from the outside when straightened for home and wore that one down under firm handling. GOSPEL NATIVE broke alertly from between horses, allowed the early leader to go, stalked that one from the outside, raced between horses in the second flight through the final turn, went after that leader and took over into the final turn, clear, responded when the winner challenged entering the stretch and gave ground grudgingly to that rival. DR J Y. G raced off the pace and the inside, was four wide through the second turn and onto the backstretch for the second time, raced three wide through the final bend, could do little with the top two in the drive, clear of the rest. CAPTAIN HAMAZING off the pace while racing inside, moved closer while continuing to save ground through the second bend, had little left for the final quarter. REDFORK took control after the start toward the inside, a bit keen into the first turn, continued to set the pace for five furlongs then stopped when headed by the runner up late on the backstretch and into the final bend. This race was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
