GOSPEL DON prompted the leader down the stretch the first time, chased that one while off the inside the middle quarter mile, quickly took over when asked late backstretch, quickly clear far turn and was not serious threatened in the drive while being kept to task. STREET BLESS'N forwardly placed the opening half mile in the three path, moved closest to the winner in the second bend, raced on the inside into the lane, chased the winner to the wire, clear of the others. HEZA FAST MAN settled toward the inside the opening furlong, moved out and raced three wide up the backstretch and into the final turn, staged a mild rally to annex the show, not a serious threat to the top two. JONESBOOGIE last to leave, raced back early inside, continued to save ground, asked along and moved a bit closer through the final bend, flattened out in the drive, not enough for third. LUCKYBLINGMOUNTAIN asked early with a right handed crop to make the early advantage, showed the way inside, gave way when headed by the winner late backstretch, continued to falter. ARIMUS fell well back after the start, continued to lag and was never involved. This race was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
