LITTLE RAG DOLL did everything possible to avoid participating before the start, including prompting a rider change, remained unruly until loaded, then apparently reconsidered, showed good speed from the break, dueled an outside rival into submission while under a drive, drew clear turning for home to prevail, then returned being uncooperative after galloping out. SPACED OUT was last into the first turn, was carried out about five wide, advanced into contention with a middle move under urging, finished with good interest but could not reach the winner in time. DOTTIE C hustled up to vie between rivals on the first turn, came on to the backstretch together with LITTLE RAG DOLL, pressed that one to the stretch, then weakened in the drive. R TWO R BADBAKER went three wide into the first turn in pursuit of the lead, lost some ground while racing wide on that turn, continued in the three path down the backstretch, and flattened out before reaching the stretch. JEALOUS was off a beat slow, then held up behind the trip, contesting the early lead, settled in well off the pace along the rail, dropped back to last on the backstretch, got a couple of reminders to pick up the pace, but did not respond. TALK ABOUT TAYLOR drifted wide on the first turn, continued a wide path the rest of the way, and was never a factor. This race was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
