GIGIS GUCCI GLASSES broke well, dueled gamely, drifted in, got nod. DOCS PANDA ducked in, dueled outside foe, lost bob, just missed. PRETTY LIL POISON ducked out at the start, steady effort for 3rd. AM DASHING LIVEWIRE lugged out into foe start, bumped another near wire. SHEZA A HOT SECRET clean trip, not good enough. PEVS WIRE TO WIRE got a good start but needed more in the late stages. CHICKS DIG TATE stumbled at the start, and did not factor. TURNPIKE PRINCESS got squeezed at the break, then lost the path midway. HOTWIRE SILOS crowded and steadied early, took up, no late bid.
