SABRES broke alertly, set a mildly pressured pace, edged away after half-mile, and widened the advantage through the later stages. MIZ RITHYM stalked SABRES from the inside path, did not kick on with that rival after passing the half-mile marker, kept up the chase, and held on second. BLUEBERRY EYES settled in midpack, kept on through the stretch but was unable to overhaul the runner-up while well clear of the others. LAUGHING OUT LOUD was unhurried early, saved ground near the rear, angled out around a tiring rival on the far turn and failed to threaten. MUCHO MIA raced three wide before dropping to the rail on the last turn, angled four wide into the stretch, and lacked the needed response. STRAWBERRY SUNDAE secured a good early position, pressed the pace two to three wide, gave way approaching the half-mile pole, and faded from contention. LOOKIN LUCKY AGAIN dropped back to last on the second pass down the backstretch and could not keep up in the late stages. This race was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
