FIRST BID dropped back early, made a three wide bid near the three sixteenths pole and finished strongly to edge clear under strong handling. SHARP LORENZO pressed the pace, took command, raced well clear near the three eighths pole and kept on to finish second best. BLESSED VISION stalked the pace along the inside, shifted out three wide to take aim but had not enough for the top pair. EMANCIPATION raced wide around the first turn, made a two to three wide bid through the far turn and needed more. BRICKLAYER was of slowly, raced two to three wide and raced evenly with no closing run. CHARMING TIGER dropped back early, raced from the inside down the backstretch and failed to respond. TREVAGGIO failed to sustain a bid. TOWN HERO void of early speed, raced far back and never threatened. COLD FACT showed good early speed along the inside, was done early and eased through the stretch. This race was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
