MOR JAZZ pressed from the outside of Gran Chico and just got under all out pressure. GRAN CHICO set a pressured early pace along the inside and just missed in a game effort. LEXINGTON RIVER lunged at the break, stalked the pace, had a three to four wide run and finished willingly to the wire. KANT BEAT THE ROCK stalked the pace along the inside and had not enough. BIG HEARTED FACTOR slow early on and failed to respond. SUITABLE showed little.
