ARMY KID vied for the early lead along the inside and held well to prove best under strong handling. BUTHESPREEY dropped back early, had a three to four wide bid and finished second best. AHOOGA stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and kept on willingly to the wire. CHARLEY PRIDE moved up four wide near the three sixteenths pole and flattened out. MITOLA pressed the pace from the outside and weakened. MALIBREW raced four wide into the upper stretch and had no response. PAKULA failed to sustain a bid. NOTIME FORMISCHIEF saved ground and never threatened. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times available.
