LAYLA'S SONG dropped back early, moved strongly three wide then angled inside rivals into the far turn and quickly went clear then held the margin through the lane. MIZ CALI stalked the pace four and five wide, challenged in the far turn but could not go with the winner while edging clear for the place. DOC'S JOY was just off the pace four and five wide to the far turn and came up empty in the lane. CHILD PROOF rallied three wide in the far turn and continued with a mild bid in the lane. NATUSIA saved ground and moved up late but could not threaten. ART QUEEN saved ground and improved position through the lane. JILL'S LEMON DROP prompted the early pace three or four wide and weakened nearing the lane. BROWN LIAISON saved ground and failed to mount a bid. ANNA'S DREAM showed early speed inside rivals and weakened. UNKNOWN CALLER was with the early leaders and weakened. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times available.
