NOBLE REIGN was with the leaders through the first turn from along the inside, settled back just off the pace, rallied back to challenge midway up the backstretch and edge clear in the far turn then widened into the lane and held the margin under steady handling. RUIZ JUNIOR was on the pace two to three wide inside rivals in the second turn, relinquished the lead into the far turn and continued on to regain second. ALL HONORS prompted the pace three and four wide between rivals then outside, bid into the lane and could not sustain the move to lose the place late. DIRTY DEAL moved up three wide while not a threat. KENNEDY'S CAUSE was always back. SWEET MUSIC MAN prompted the pace three or four wide to late backstretch and tired. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was retimed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times available
