PRINCE IS MY BOY saved ground back off the early pace, rallied three wide to bid between rivals nearing the lane, reeled in MOR JAZZ and went clear late. MOR JAZZ pressed the pace outside CAJUN COUNTRY to bid and move clear into the lane then could not contain the winners late run. OPTIMAL TRIP was three to five wide in reach of the pace, moved up but could not close on the top pair in the lane. LETSHAVEONEMORE tracked the early pace three or four wide and weakened. BRANNIGAN failed to mount a rally three and four wide. KANT BEAT THE ROCK was always back. CAJUN COUNTRY showed the most early speed to cross over and gain inside position, made the pace to the far turn and tired. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
