KO SAMUI (IRE) stalked the leaders along the inside, rallied through the lane and was going clear late. SUNDAY BLING made the pace on a short lead about the two or three path and could not hold the winner off late. SARAH'S VISION tracked the pace three and four wide and could not produce the needed late surge. SIDE STREET DAVE prompted the early pace three wide and weakened. COWORKER followed the pace four wide and weakened. LITTLE BITOTHUNDER was not a threat four wide. PRINTS MONEY was not a factor. JUST LUCK saved ground and was not a factor. JAKE THE GREAT had his rider lose irons at the start and dropped far back.
