CANDY LOOKER brushed inner foe at the start, was rated along the inside, launched a three wide bid at the top of the stretch to drive past the competition with authority. LAST GASP stalked the early pace four wide, contested the lead through the turn, took charge at the three sixteenths but yielded to the winner in the final yards. WICKED SKY opted to be the early trailer, rallied well in the stretch to earn the show award. PRIMITY brushed outer foe at the start, moved up along the inside to vie for command, weakened down the stretch, got out-finished for the show award. GRAZEN GATOR settled between runners, swung out seven wide at the top of the stretch, closed willingly. WILDWOOD ENCORE broke swiftly for a brief lead, settled back to chase the dueling leaders through the turn, entered the stretch five wide but flattened out. I BE GONE wide trip, no impact. AIR GERRI split foes for a narrow lead shortly after the start, vied for command between foes in the turn, surrendered at the quarter pole and retreated down the stretch.
