ICY RIVER vied for the early lead with CANTOO, led briefly before being overtaken by WHAT'S CRACKIN at the half mile pole, reclaimed command at the three eighths, drew clear of the field in the stretch. MAMA'S MEMORIES was reluctant to load the gate and delayed the start, stumbled at the start, advanced to track the pace three wide, made no final bid. SPICY DELIGHT settled not too far back four wide, rallied well down the stretch but just missed the place award. WILDWOOD BYE opted to be the early trailer, closed willingly along the outside of the stretch. CANTOO vied for the early lead alongside ICY RIVER, settled back shortly after the start, unable to close in the stretch. WHAT'S CRACKIN was reluctant to load the gate, rushed up to take charge at the half mile pole, conceded the lead to ICY RIVER at the three eighths, faded down the stretch. SALLY'S SUPRISE tracked the pace between foes, lacked any response, retreated.
