SPLENDOR GLOW was quick to assume command just off the rail, came under pressure from a couple foes in the turn, fought hard to maintain his diminishing advantage and just lasted. RICHOCHET RICK shadowed the pace setter from the three path, moved up to contest the lead in the turn, brushed with NINE OH ONE a couple times in the upper stretch, battled hard in the final furlong between foes but just missed. NINE OH ONE tracked the pace from the four path, closed in through the turn to enter the stretch in a prominent position, brushed with RICHOCHET RICK a couple times in the upper stretch, showed a good effort in the final furlong but was out-finished. LAST ARROW chased the pace from the inside, weakened in the final furlong. TAP THE PRIZE broke slowly, trailed throughout.
