ZOOMBIE moved to the lead inside by the half, set a pressured pace into and on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, drifted out a bit while widening late. SMART JOKER got away well with the early lead from outside, was overtaken and pressed the eventual winner, proved no match but second best. SHADOWLESS stalked early before advancing three to four wide into and on the turn, was in contention coming to the quarter pole but lost ground into upper stretch and ran on evenly late. GET THROUGH lacked early speed despite encouragement, was ridden along chasing outside four to five wide on the turn, fanned seven deep, was never a threat. MAQAMAT dropped back along the inside losing ground on the leaders into the turn, came out a bit for the stretch and ran on. KHOZAN'S VALENTINE reared at the start, was urged forward between runners but faced traffic about the half, continued chasing inside on the turn, faded in the stretch. PARTYINTHESTREETS chased between runners into the turn two to three wide, moved out four wide by the quarter pole and six deep coming into upper stretch under a ride, faltered.
