WESLAN urged along inside to keep pace into the turn, swung out five wide into the lane, captured weary pace setter approaching the furlong marker, kicked away driving for the score. GRAYHOP settled well off the pace and off the rail into the turn, clean rail bid into the lane, rallied with good energy for the place award. VOLODYMYR Z broke sharp, set a swift solo pace around the turn, under pressure and running on the wrong lead, wandered in deep stretch, flattened out saved the show. TAHOE RUN chased the swift pace inside around the turn, tipped four wide for the stretch, finished with interest. ADIOS KID pressed between runners around the turn, took aim five wide into the lane, came up empty through the final sixteenth. GOD GUNS N GUTS outrun into the turn, had no late response. FAST CROSS TRAFFIC pressed five wide around the turn, roused six deep into the lane, gave way from the furlong marker.
