EARL'S OUTLAW advanced four wide up the backstretch into the turn, bid at the quarter pole getting a brief lead but drifted out several paths leaving the turn relinquishing the advantage, dug in through the stretch to get up late. KARAZEST was bumped at the start but still obtained a brief early lead, pressed the new leader from outside three wide, retook the lead at the three-eighths, was headed at the quarter pole but cornered well to retake possession, fought on but was nailed late. LIES N DECEPTION got away well, stalked from outside, went five to six wide on the turn, drifted nine wide into upper stretch, ran on. WARSHIN MACHINE bumped a rival and lost an iron at the start, recovered and pursued from inside, was off the rail in the stretch to pass a tiring rival and improve. K J 'S RANSOM shifted in a bit early but still off the fence, was one-paced. POSITION OUR LUCK lacked early speed dropping well back, passed a tired rival. SUMMER CYCLONE was urged forward inside, took the lead after three-sixteenths, led briefly up the backstretch, gave way in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.

XAVI tracked from inside, moved out five wide near the five-sixteenths outside the leading pair, came into upper stretch eight wide, drove past in mid-stretch and cleared. Q B NINE was bumped at the start but still obtained the early lead, was joined by an inside foe, dueled outside that one going four wide on the turn, was carried out a couple paths leaving the bend, kept on in the stretch to hold the place. AMERICAN WARRIOR pursued from outside five to seven wide on the turn, drifted eleven deep coming out of that bend, kept on but just missed the place. CHRYSO ALOGO got away well, stalked the leading pair kept well off the inside, raced in the four to six path on the turn and was ridden along past the five-sixteenths, drifted and was carried out leaving the turn entering upper stretch nine wide, ran on. SWEET LA CREMA bobbed then bumped with a foe at the start, moved forward inside to contest the pace but kept well off the rail, went into the turn in the three path taking a narrow lead leaving the backstretch, vied through the turn drifting six wide into upper stretch, gave way. GA MO TAK (CHI) lacked early speed racing well back early near the inside, ran on evenly. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.

DARK VINTAGE (IRE) moved forward inside to take the lead past the five-eighths, was earnestly challenged by the outside rival dueling through the turn, drew off when asked. COMMITTEE OF ONE had the early lead but was soon overtaken to the inside by the eventual winner, stalked that one then moved to challenge on the turn dueling through that bend, was no match but second best. DIAMONDONICE exchanged a light bump at the start, was off the leading pair chasing four to five wide on the turn, proved no match for that duo. BUREAU exchanged a light bump at the start, raced outside foes at the back on the turn four to five wide swinging wider still for the drive, failed to menace. WILDWOOD RUBEN broke a half-step slowly, was at the back near but off the inside, moved out four deep past the five-sixteenths, was in just a hair tight near the quarter pole, failed to menace. RHODIUMS PRIDE switched outside the leaders in the early going, chased that pair well back racing in the three path into the turn, dropped back and faded. SMOKED sped clear to dictate terms from off the fence, had enough in reserve to hold. DISGUISED DEVIL switched out off the inside early, stalked from the three to four path on the turn, was carried out by a drifting foe in mid-stretch, gained on the leader but too late. LALY pursued from between runners about mid-pack going four wide on the turn, fanned eight deep out of that bend, kept on late to improve. BELLEINTHETEMPLE stalked the eventual winner from outside three to four wide, proved no match. LA ROSE BLANCHE was up close to the leader and eventual winner shifting in, made a mild bid up the rail near the quarter pole but had no extra but saved show. RATHER LATE moved out early up the backstretch, raced inside a rival off the pace into the turn, gradually fanned out leaving that bend coming into upper stretch ten deep, kept on and missed show honors. KRAZY LIKE BETH chased from mid-pack, was carried eleven wide leaving the turn by an inside foe, ran on. LADY ARTIST chased briefly inside, dropped back up the backstretch, kept on evenly to improve. TINY TOT QUEEN was lightly bumped up the backstretch, moved up past foes in the second flight, continued four to five wide on the turn, weakened in the stretch. O'HARA AT DAWN raced wide throughout and was never near enough to threaten. HOLLY SPRINGS was forced outside foes heading up the backstretch, chased between runners, shifted in for the turn, came up empty. DARK DIAMOND chased from between runners in the second flight on the turn, fanned out nine wide turning for home, faded. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF HOLLY SPRINGS AGAINST RATHER LATE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
