WICKED SKY broke a step slowly and was forced out just after, was forced five wide into the first turn, shifted in a bit up the backstretch, advanced between runners three wide three furlongs out, moved out after that point advancing on the leading group but was carried seven deep passing the quarter pole, struck the lead in upper stretch while drifting in, kicked clear and lasted. BEST MAN SPEECH settled at the back off the rail, moved out to advance past rivals six deep past the quarter pole, came into upper stretch eight wide, was gaining late. REVEILLE VALLEY was forwardly-positioned inside on or just off the rail and just in behind the leader into the first turn, moved up to take the lead at the three-quarters, was pressed up the backstretch into the far turn, bore out passing the quarter pole, was overtaken in upper stretch but fought on to regain show honors. SEVERANCE broke out a bit, shifted in on the first turn settling mid-pack, advanced inside on or just off the rail on the far turn, bid inside at the three-sixteenths, lacked the needed late kick. NIGHTWIND exchanged a bump at the start, shifted in nearer the fence racing toward the back early, saved ground on the far turn and improved position. PETE'S LEGACY was bumped between runners at the start, caught three to four wide in the early going racing off the pace, shifted in and saved some ground near the inside on the far turn, was never near enough to threaten. GOLD JERRY chased four wide first between then outside foes in the early going, was encouraged along by the seven-sixteenths, carried out six wide at the quarter pole, faltered in the stretch. OUR HEAVENLY GIFT was up close into the first turn taking hold and dropping back then switching outside foes about five wide early on that bend, stalked mid-pack kept very wide, dropped back and failed

to menace. LAKE OF FIRE went soon to the lead, set the pace from off the rail, pressed the new leader up the backstretch, was carried out and put in tight quarters by that rival about the quarter pole, was eased in the stretch and walked off. SMILE LIKE KYLE exchanged contact at the start, was up close caught five wide into the first turn, stalked early up the backstretch, retreated four wide on the far turn, fanned out for the drive, was not persevered with and walked off.
