ZOOMBIE stalked from between runners three wide heading to the turn, shifted to the rail midway on that bend once clear of foes, bid inside taking the lead passing the quarter pole, drew clear despite drifting out late. MAQAMAT was off the pace racing last but one heading into the turn, moved out from three to five wide on that bend forced outside runners, swung nine wide into upper stretch, came in through the lane and ran on to get up for place. LAYTON THE DAY was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail, was overtaken by an inside foe late on the turn, had no extra. WHISKEYINATEACUP lacked early speed bringing up the rear and switching out off the inside prior to the half, swung eleven wide into upper stretch, kicked on mildly late. TWIRLING ROSES chased from inside, lacked the needed late kick. LOOKIN FOR BALA chased from between runners, was in a bit tight steadying just slightly past the three-eighths, moved out four wide soon after, swung wider still for the drive, failed to threaten late. BERNIE LOMAX chased from outside four to five wide, faded.
