CRUSHED ICE moved up inside to assume command near the half mile pole, swung out leaving the turn, was under pressure through the stretch and held on gamely. TWO HEARTED was void of early speed, got through along the rail leaving the turn, went willingly to the wire, couldn't get by the winner and was outfinished in a good effort. BEE BLUFF raced close to the pace, rallied three wide into the turn, challenged for the lead, was carried out entering the stretch, dropped back, finished evenly and held for show. DESSERT FIRST got away well, advanced to the second turn, bid off the rail, was within range and lacked the needed late response. IZZY'S MONSTER bumped twice after the start, saved ground to the second turn, angled out and gave way. SAVANNAMARIE bumped twice after the start, was void of early speed, raced evenly and was not a threat. FAST N HAPPY drew off on the first turn, set the pace while racing well off the rail, was checked on the second turn, stopped and was not urged late.
