ANNA AFTER MIDNITE soon led, forced the pace from off the rail, edged clear three furlongs out, drifted a bit leaving the turn, held sway while drifting out a bit late. FREEDOM ATTACK was forwardly-placed pursuing from inside, came out late on the turn to be four wide at the top of the stretch, was carried out a bit in late stretch then altered inside the winner chasing that one home. ORNERY ANGEL was lightly bumped into a rival at the start, chased from inside foes but well off the rail, moved to the two path for the turn, kept on inside late. SCRAPBOOK chased up close early then continued in pursuit up the backstretch and into the turn five wide, fanned out nine deep leaving that bend, was best of the rest. ECHO DREAMER was lightly brushed by a rival nearing the half and moved out wider at that juncture, was six wide into the turn floating ten wide out of that bend, failed to threaten. GOODBYE INDY was lightly bumped at the start, unhurriedly brought up the rear, was off the rail through the turn, swung seven wide into upper stretch, tipped out further and ran on evenly. TAPICITA bumped a rival lightly at the start then exchanged incidental contact with another up the backstretch while chasing between, was asked for more at the five-sixteenths racing three wide, failed to rally. I'M INTERESTED broke well and was among the early leaders, pursued the eventual winner from outside, drifted seven wide into upper stretch and came up empty.
