BABY I'M HAMMERED contended for the lead outside a wall of horses, put a head in front near the half then edged clear at the seven-sixteenths, shifted in a bit to dictate terms but still off the fence, asked in upper stretch and widened a bit then held safe. EARL'S OUTLAW broke just a bit awkwardly and lacked speed from the gate, soon made an early advance outside foes five wide into and on the turn, kept on but was only second best. ILLINI RED vied between runners early, chased two to three wide on the turn, kept on evenly. SOMETHINTOBELIEVEN had brief speed between foes then chased from inside, came out six wide in upper- to mid-stretch and ran on. WILDWOOD BELL was fractious in the gate, lacked early speed despite encouragement chasing in behind a wall of horses off the inside, switched outside foes further about the half, chased four to five wide on the turn still ridden along, swung wider still for the drive and was never near enough to threaten. ADAM FIVE OH was forwardly-placed between runners early and among the leaders, altered out at the half, chased four wide on the turn, failed to rally. LAST RETURN was fractious in the gate, reloaded soon after but was reluctant to do so, broke a step slowly and lacked early speed racing off the inside, fanned seven to nine wide and passed rivals. PLAYGROUND WARRIOR vied inside for the early lead then continued to chase, saved ground on the turn, faded in the stretch. FIGHT THE POWER chased from mid-pack three wide into the turn, steadily retreated. SENOR RUBEN was among the early leaders then chased two to three wide late up the backstretch, was in tight about the seven-sixteenths dropping back, raced near the inside the remainder of the turn and faded in the stretch.
