ESCOVEDO bumped at the start, vied to the turn, assumed command, drew off under urging and widened. GOLDEN EDGE broke out, bobbled and brushed at the start, raced close to the pace along the inside, put in a steady effort and earned place while no match for the winner. LAST GASP bumped at the start, seta pressured pace to the turn, weakened in the drive, faded from contention and just held for show. COOKIN THE BOOKS stalked the pace, dropped back on the turn and came up empty late. INTO GOLDEN ROAD brushed at the start, lagged early, swung wide entering the stretch and offered a mild bid only. GRAZEN GATOR put in an even effort in an outside trip and did not threaten. CANDY LOOKER was pinched back after the start and outrun in a wide trip.
