SKYLANE was never far back, raced inside, shifted out on the turn, bid four wide, assumed command and drew clear late under mild urging. CUTLASS KING broke out and bumped at the start, stalked the pace, rallied three wide on the turn, assumed command, led briefly, fought back when headed and was no match late. PETE'S LEGACY was unhurried early, saved ground, advanced along the rail on the turn, was steadied into the stretch, shifted out, bid off the rail and finished well to earn show. RECAUSE bumped on both sides at the start, was slow early, advanced inside on the second turn, bid three wide and closed well. T LAW pressed the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. REVEILLE VALLEY was hustled along to set a pressured pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. GRANDSONSAM bumped at the start, trailed the field, went widest in the drive and was outrun. W W STAR stalked the pace, was through after a half and dropped back steadily. ARKY ROAD raced mid pack in an even effort and lacked a bid.
