BILDERBERG dueled inside a foe early, put that one away but was headed by a different outside foe, regained the lead past mid-stretch and edged away under steady handling. KING ANTHONY exchanged a light brush at the start, stalked just off and outside dueling leaders, advanced on those three to four wide making a bid at the quarter pole, held a narrow lead into mid-stretch but was outfinished. CALL ME CHRISTINE exchanged incidental contact at the start, stalked the leading trio from off the inside going in the four to five path into the turn, advanced on the leaders passing the five-sixteenths, drifted eight wide into upper stretch losing some ground in the process, ran on evenly. I NEED MORE MONEY settled off the pace inside, saved ground through the turn, kept on evenly. PERSONAL JET chased from outside and was forced five wide into the turn, dropped back off a rival and shifted in three wide saving some ground before tipping back out for the drive, failed to make a bid. BEST MAN SPEECH was well back early, swung six to seven wide and was never near enough to threaten. TIME TO TOAST contested the early pace then vied between foes into the turn, faltered and faded.
