FASTTIMESATMIDNITE got away a tad slowly then was urged forward, advanced between runners up the backstretch, moved out from three to five wide late on the turn and asked for more passing the quarter pole, kept on in late stretch and drove past late. D' ARGONAUT stalked early then moved up to draw even at the half dueling into the turn, took the lead early on that bend, edged clear by the quarter pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch, was collared in deep stretch. GIRLS KNICKS NOW settled mid-pack two wide, took closer order on the turn shifting out four wide for the drive, kept on late in behind the top two. SAFECRACKER SUE settled mid-division inside, saved ground on the turn moving out a path to pass a tiring rival near the quarter pole, kept on inside to improve position. DIVA LAS VEGAS broke out, moved forward and shifted in, was taken up from the five-eighths to the nine-sixteenths and switched outside that pair, moved up in range three wide coming to the five-sixteenths but evened out in the lane. FLATHEAD FINALE was between runners up the backstretch, dropped back about two to three wide into the turn, fanned six wide out of that bend and passed tired rivals. JACK'S YELLOW ROSE was a half-step slow and lacked early speed, was forced outside foes on the turn racing five to six deep, came into upper stretch eight wide and improved position. MADAM LEE dropped back soon after the start, raced on or just off the inside, failed to menace. COWGIRL FRANKIE broke a half-step slowly, move up heading up the backstretch to reach mid-pack, chased three to four wide into the turn, steadily retreated. WILDWOOD OVERTIME was reluctant to load, broke sharply and quickly clear shifting in to set the pace, was soon joined by an outside foe briefly dueling, gave way.
