MAJOR LEAGUE away in good order, pressed between into the turn, no late kick. MAYA'S WARRIOR broke sharp, contested the pace four wide, faded stretch. PREMOR pressed off the rail and off the pace, no late impact. LAST CALL GENO veered in start, ducked in chute, six wide left lead, weakened. ALLKINDSOFTROUBLE prompted the pace inside around the turn, gave way upper. KICK THE A. T. M. fractious in the gate pre-start, never threatened.

PEOPLE FORCE veered out at the start, four wide pursuit, caught foe, resolute. EUCLID AVENUE broke sharp, widened the margin into the far turn, game try. MYSTIC POWER rated off the pace between into the far turn, five wide rallied. STRONGER TOGETHER chased the pace along the rail into the far turn, bid stalled out. BOOGIE BODE rated around the first, pressed between into far turn, no kick. HANDSOFFTHEGOODS very slow into stride, roused well off the pace three wide, empty. HEARTBREAK GAME raced off the pace three and four wide, never factored. LUCKY BOSS slow start, never involved. PAYNT BY LETTERS saved ground off the pace, never threatened. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

RUMBLING settled off the pace early on, raced between the two groups down the backstretch, moved up into contention late on the backstretch, advanced on the leaders through the turn, then came out to the three-path, wore down LICENSE TO STEAL and another rival on the inside and edged ahead in the final yards. LICENSE TO STEAL was pushed from the start to get forward position, moved up on the clubhouse turn to join REVEILLE VALLEY on the lead, moved to a solo lead on the far turn, opened up a clear lead before the stretch, battled rivals inside and outside through the stretch, but came up short and had to settle for second. HEAVENS HOUND backed off the potential speed duel on the first turn and took up a nice tracking position along the rail, was always close up, waited for room heading into the far turn, moved out to the three-path late on the turn, dove down to the rail in upper stretch and finished willingly but was not quite doing enough in the final stages. GRANDSONSAM was the distant early trailer made a forward move down the backstretch, then made a belated four-wide rally to improve. T LAW stalked the pacesetter two-wide through the early running, started to lose ground heading into the far turn, and dropped out of contention. BEST MAN SPEECH toiled at the rear through the early stages, swung out four or five wide into the stretch and lacked a finish. REVEILLE VALLEY pressed the pace to the inside for a half-mile, then weakened midway on the far turn and tired. BAD OBSESSION was unhurried early and never fired.

JET PACK vied five-wide, went on from the three-furlong pole, was taken on by two rivals past the quarter poe, lost the lead then stormed back inside the furling pole and surges clear in the final yards. SALLY'S SUPRISE settled widest of all down the backstretch, circled the field on the turn, loomed a big threat late in the stretch but was oufinished. AROSE FOR LILY settled widest in the second flight, made a sharp middle move through the turn to bid three-wide for the lead at the top of the stretch, dueled with HOT T'MATER through the final stages and gained the upper hand over that stubborn foe in the final yards. HOT T'MATER dueled for the lead from the start, disposed of two early challengers near the quarter pole then took on a new bid from AROSE FOR LILLY from the top of the stretch, battled that rival gamely through the length of the stretch and gave way grudgingly in the shadow of the wire. RICHIESGOLDENGIRL tracked from mid-pack down the backstretch, tipped out four-wide into the stretch, finished up well and was closing the gap on the top two but ran out of time. TRY rushed up after the break to vie with two rivals to the outside for the early advantage, gave way before the quarter pole, kept on, but steadied near the sixteenths marker and lost any remaining chance. LAUREN'S WAR outpaced from the start, made a solid belated rally to improve position. PASSING PASSION raced between rivals in the second flight, moved up early on the turn but lacked a clear forward path, idled near the quarter pole, swung out five or six wide and tried to rally

but flattened out in the final furlong. I DID THE MATH lacked early speed and raced near the back early, dropped down to the inside on the turn and continued to run on up the rail with some late interest to improve. HARPER BRIANA got bounced around after the start, was in the back half of the field early and lacked a finish. LADIES LEGACY raced in range of the leaders early, came under a ride to keep up late on the turn, loomed with a chance in upper stretch, but flattened out. HANABI chased from mid-pack, then weakened midway through the turn and had nothing to offer late. CHASING SEATTLE was outrun early and lacked a finish. SHOW PAM disputed the pace three-deep to the stretch, then tired.

SANTINO'S FANTASY was away well, settled five-wide in the second flight, launched a bid just before the three-furlong pole, came four abreast with rivals at the head of the stretch, and finished well under steady handling and urging to prevail. LATIN CASINO was the inside horse in the tracking group, lacked a clear path forward through the turn, remained in range, slipped through the inside near the three-sixteenths marker, and finished strong to be second best. IDEA MAN settled back off the early pace, was four or five wide through the turn and into the stretch closed in late but could not get up in time. JUNIOR BUG was slow into stride, launched a five to six wide bid through the turn, and finished up well to improve. GRANDDADDYLONGLEGS disputed the pace between foes, dueled FULL MAGAZINE through the turn, kept on with good courage but was outfinished in the late stages. CANTSTEALMYTHUNDER showed no early interest, swung about eight or nine wide into the stretch and finished with a rush but was much too late. MINNESOTA MOON broke well but backed off the early pace scramble, stayed to the inside, came out to the three path for the stretch run and showed some mild late interest. HIGHLY PERFECT was four-wide in the tracking group, dropped off the pace on the turn and went one-paced through the lane. FULL MAGAZINE contested the

pace from the rail to the stretch, and weakened in the final furlong. AWESOME OUTLAW chased in the middle of the pack and failed to menace. KARAYEL was very slow away from the gate, was steered to the rail but was never a factor.
