OUR JUJU was lightly brushed after the start, lacked early speed racing off the inside, shifted in late up the backstretch, advanced inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch, rallied past taking over seventy yards from home and drew clear. RISING CREEK broke inwardly then was encouraged forward to soon take the lead, set the pace inside on or just off the rail, was well clear in mid-stretch, ducked in and checked in late stretch losing the lead but held second. DUBLIN DROP got away well, was overtaken for the lead, stalked up close from outside two to three wide, ran on. W W CASH was urged from the start, chased inside mid-division into the turn, came out midway on that bend then swung six deep turning into upper stretch, kept on with late effort but needed more. BOURBON AMERICANA broke in a bit, was well-placed stalking from off the inside in the three path through the turn, ran on evenly. TRUE EFFECT broke a step slowly and in tight, moved up outside in pursuit four wide into and on the turn, failed to rally. ELSIE'S LEGACY was lightly bumped into a rival at the start, chased from outside a foe mid-pack going two to three wide on the turn, swung seven deep for the drive, failed to menace. WATCHTHEWINDBLOWBY bumped a rival lightly at the start, was ridden along while outpaced and never a threat. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

GRACE MET CUPID set the pace inside just off the rail shadowed by the eventual winner into the turn, drifted to the five path leaving that bend, was overtaken in upper- to mid-stretch, was no match but held the place. CRAVENSWORTH lacked early speed bringing up the rear, saved ground, rallied inside, was in tight near the seventy yard marker but carried on to get up for show. TRUIST stalked from off the inside racing in the three to four path on the turn, drifted a bit in the stretch, was outfinished for show. STUNNING BRUNO was prominent between foes early, chased the top pair dropping back while shifting in early on the turn, saved ground, ran on in the stretch but needed more. AFTER MY BROTHER was off the pace inside saving ground through the turn, came out in the stretch and ran on. QUALITY STORM chased from outside four to six wide, weakened. EL JEFE COBB switched out off the inside racing last but one up the backstretch, went in the three to four path on the turn, swung seven wide into upper stretch, failed to rally. FROSTED WARRIOR shifted in chasing outside a rival two to three wide on the turn, faltered and faded in the stretch.

ILLINI RED came in and bumped a rival entering the first turn, moved forward three wide stalking the leader, bid at the three-eighths, drew clear, was much the best. SOMETHINTOBELIEVEN was bumped entering the first turn, settled just off the leaders two to three wide, moved out up the backstretch then back in for the second turn, passed rivals inside in the stretch and was second best. WILDWOOD BELL was forwardly-placed outside five wide into the first turn shifting in a bit, stalked up the backstretch, was encouraged by the five-sixteenths, kept on one-paced. EARL'S OUTLAW shifted in early racing in the two path about mid-pack into the first turn, advanced between foes on the far turn, came out in upper stretch and ran on. ITDONTCOMEeasy shot clear early to set the pace inside, was overtaken early on the far turn, switched out at the top of the stretch, faded. ADAM FIVE OH bobbled at the start, trailed far back early, swung four wide into upper stretch, shifted in at that juncture and improved position. MIKE'S LAST CALL switched out in the early going racing in the three to four path on the first turn and well off the pace, was asked for more at the half but had no response and went evenly. CIAO TOMMASO tracked from inside just off the leaders, retreated three furlongs out coming out a bit leaving the far turn and faded thereafter. RAZ ON FIRE was off the pace and well off the inside racing in the three to five path, was unable to factor. CHEF RAY WILEY shifted in on the first turn, failed to menace. DASH TO THE CASH

was a bit fractious in the gate and broke a step slowly, was forced five to six wide early and was not a factor.

CITIZEN EX was up close outside pursuing five wide into the turn, floated nine wide into upper stretch, kept on. CHIEF GROSS was up close in pursuit four wide, floated eight deep turning for home, lacked the needed late kick. HELMO THE GREAT lacked early speed racing outside at the rear into the turn, shifted in leaving that turn, steadied at the furlong marker when in tight, ran on late to improve. WILL CONQUER chased from outside mid-pack five to six wide through the turn, swung ten wide into upper stretch, needed more late. STORMY ATTACK was a bit fractious in the gate, pressed the eventual winner, drifted out leaving the turn and came up empty. K J 'S RANSOM settled off the pace racing inside, saved ground on the turn, swung five wide into upper stretch then veered in drastically near the furlong marker and came up empty. POSITION OUR LUCK chased briefly three to four wide, dropped back and faded.
