SEMINOLE BEACH settled off the pace racing outside, went five to six wide through the turn, ground on in the lane and got up late. IDEA MAN tossed the head at the start, settled mid-division, went five wide on the turn advancing to take a narrow lead in upper stretch, led till late but was caught. PONTUS hopped at the start then was urged forward, moved to the lead five wide past the seven-sixteenths and clear by the three-eighths shifting in, was challenged in upper stretch, yielded but saved third. LOU MAN settled off the pace saving ground on the turn, began moving out late on that bend coming into upper

stretch six wide, had a good late effort narrowly missing show honors. CRAVENSWORTH was off the pace toward the rear three to five wide through the turn, swung nine deep for the drive, ran on mildly late. HIGHLY PERFECT chased dropping back between foes, raced five wide on the turn, swung eleven wide into upper stretch and ran on with mild late interest. COG vied three wide between foes into the turn, weakened in the stretch. STUNNING BRUNO had a minor brush at the start, dueled outside a foe then vied between runners, dropped back on the turn and was carried out a bit late on that bend, faded in the stretch. T LAW exchanged a minor brush at the start, lacked speed racing at the back inside, saved ground on the turn, came out in the stretch, failed to menace. FULL MAGAZINE exchanged minor brushes at the start, was urged forward dueling inside for the lead, came up empty. AWESOME DREW contended four wide between foes into the turn, steadily retreated.
