GOOD APPLE broke very sharp, widened the margin throughout, unchallenged drew away driving through the final sixteenth. MIDNITE ALEX chased the runaway winner three wide into the lane, left lead well off the rail, chased on bested the rest. GRAYHOP raced off the pace into the turn, called up four deep through the stretch, along final stages for the show. FAST CROSS TRAFFIC very slow into stride, bid off the pace between leaving the furlong marker, came up empty late. AWESOME DREW two wide pursuit around the turn, inside upper, left lead weakened through the wire. SPAN trailed throughout.
