CHRYSO ALOGO hustled up soon after the start, pressed the pace into the turn, dueled three deep around the band, worked hard inched clear leaving the quarter pole, under a stout drive held safe through the wire. PURPLE OCTOPUS broke in air brushed the gate at the start, spotted the field several Lenths into the turn, gained momentum five wide leaving the quarter pole, all out rallied through the final sixteenth, up for the place under the wire. DIAMONDONICE raced off the duel inside around the turn, angled off the inside four wide for the stretch run, unable to switch leads churned on through the final sixteenth, nailed late for the place. SWISS GUARD pressed on early for speed to the turn, dueled between around the bend, bid flattened out through the final sixteenth. GRANDDADDYLONGLEGS vied then dueled inside around the turn, lost a step leaving the quarter pole, faded through the lane. LONESOME DREAM chased the top trio in the pocket around the turn, under pressure leaving the quarter pole, weakened through the stretch. TRICKY MOMENT broke a step slow, roused on off the pace four wide around the turn, faltered through the lane.
